In Memorial

Twenty-one cadets and instructors died at Curtis Field while in training during World War II. This building was the last place they walked out of in this world. Never forget them or their sacrifices to this nation. This Military Memorial Annex is intended to be a living monument to all members of the services, past or present, who have answered the call to protect America. 10,000 students graduated from Curtis Field and went on into the heat of battle. 3,500 of them never returned home. Many soldiers served at the POW Camp, and some of these went on to the shores of Normandy for the invasion. The 21 cadets and instructors who died in training are listed below.
