I won't be home until the 11th. but I will have four whole days then. You know it won't be long before I will be coming home for good.

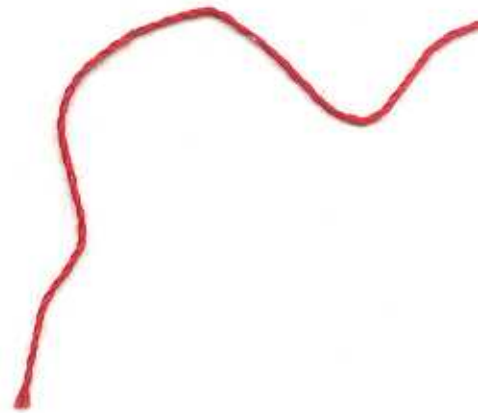
