Just remember though, Sweet, that although I may not write, it doesn't mean I've forgotten you, I'd sooner forget to eat!

Your gift came to day and I want to thank you for it, June. It was so nice of you to send me some-

thing, and if you only knew how hard
it is to get behaving better and such over
here you would know how much I
appreciate the gift.

#3 gave me the low down on
the 3rd Parade which I like very much.
So many of the boys over here have
never heard "Pistol Packin' Mama",
and when I told them it was #2,
well they couldn't believe it.

I've told you in a previous
letter that I had seen "Here To Stay"
but I haven't heard "For The First
Time". The songs that are tops over
here just now are "Heavenly Music",
"Silver Wings", "We Must Never Say
Good-bye" and "I'm Going To Get Lit
Up When The Lights Go On in London".

I think I also told you that
I didn't get to see "For Whom The Bell
Tolls" the last time I was in London,
but I hope to see it the next time
I'm there.

I have an apology to make about the pictures that I promised to send you from London. All I picked up were a few of the Abbey and I sent them to Alvin and Leonard Stewart but I'll tell you what I'm going to do. I'll shoot a few myself the next time I go in and also I'll buy some more post cards and you will be first on my list. I think I told you that I have received the first two rolls of films already and I want to say thanks again. All of you back home have been so good about sending me things and all I can say is thanks! thanks! It isn't much in return, but I mean it.

No we get our packages just as soon as they come in. That's why it seems so much like Xmas now, early in November. We'll receive them right thru to Xmas and probably a few after the day.

You seem to be staying home quite a bit of late. You say you didn't go to the mid-night show with Bess when she came. You're not getting to be a stay at home, are you? You had better stay in practice because when I get home you are likely to be asked out every nite for a few months, of course you don't have to accept but you will be asked any way. Jim in his red dress, wow!!!
