I--Awards of Air Medal--Under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, 8 August 1932, as amended, and pursuant to authority contained in Section 1, Circular 36, Headquarters, ETOUSA, 5 April 1943, and Letter, Headquarters, Eighth Air Force, 210.5 x 220.5, 16 June 1943, Subject: Awards and Decorations, an AIR MEDAL is awarded to the following named personnel:
