By direction of the President, in addition to the Air Medals, awarded in General Orders indicated by subparagraphs, the following named officers and enlisted men of the 323rd Bombardment Group (M), are awarded the BRONZE OAK LEAF CLUSTER, under the provisions of Executive Order No. 9158, (Bull. 25, WD, 1942), as amended by Executive Order No. 9242-A, (Bull. 49, WD, 1942) and in accordance with authority delegated by the War Department and contained in ETCUSA Circular # 56, dated 27 May 1944, in recognition of meritorious achievement while participating in aerial flights in the European Theater of Operations, they each having completed the required number of operational sorties against the enemy.
