Personnel involved in this movement will be advised in the clear and as early as practicable before movement to the staging area or air station of departure of the following Post Office address. They will be instructed to furnish it to their friends and relatives:

Private Richard J Roe (Army Serial No., if known)

Organization, including Company or similar designation

APO 12184 c/o Postmaster, New York, New York

Upon arrival at destination personnel will use the mailing address of the troops at that station and will be instructed to advise their friends and relatives promptly of the new address.

Items of clothing and equipment will be taken as prescribed in Schedule of Individual Clothing and Equipment Code No. 300, 12 February 1943, as issued by the Commanding General, Army Air Forces, (See provisions of Letter AAF 420, Headquarters, Army Air Forces, 28 February 1943, subject: "Individual Clothing and Equipment List for Personnel Traveling by Air to Combat Theaters") Item listed in Column C, line no. 44, and all items listed in lines nos. 27, 35, and 197 will not be issued. Items listed in column C of the schedule referred to above and other authorized baggage not required to accompany the individual by air will be marked with the individuals grade, name and serial number and shipped by rail and/or motor to New York Port of Embarkation for further movement by water. This baggage will be shipped on government bill of lading and addressed as follows: Port Transportation Officer, New York Port of Embarkation, marked with Shipment Number including crew number (Example: FJ-308-AJ-31).

Commanding Officer 336th Bomb Gp will comply with the provisions of Cir. No. 85, WD, 29 March 1943, particularly with respect to records of personnel and immunization of all air crew personnel against yellow fever, smallpox, typhoid fever, tetanus, typhus fever, and cholera.

In lieu of subsistence a flat per diem of six dollars (\$6.00) is authorized for travel and for periods of temporary duty enroute to final destination when necessary for officers and flight officers in accordance with existing laws and regulations. Payment of mileage is not authorized.

A flat per diem of six dollars (\$6.00) is authorized for enlisted men for travel and for periods of temporary duty enroute to final destination in accordance with existing laws and regulations, if travel is performed by air. PAR 35-4520 FD will pay adv the prescribed mon alws in lieu of rations and/or qtrs for 57 EM for 2/3 day for the trip to Hunter Fld, Savannah Ga, by rail.

From time of departure from the continental United States until arrival at permanent overseas station, payment of per diem is authorized for a maximum of forty-five (45) days.

During such times as the individual is billeted and subsisted, as outlined in WD Memorandum W-35-2-42, 30 September 1942, per diem will be suspended. TOT, TDM, 1-5250 P 431-01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 07, 08 A 0425-24. AUTH: Ltr AAF 370.0 (6-18-43) PUB-R-AF-M, and TIX 3BC 10974C.
