Dear Mrs. Lewis:

I wish to extend my personal sympathy and that of the Members of the Armed Forces Relief and Benefit Association, on the death of your husband. We want you to know that the United States Air Force has lost a capable officer and we of the Association, a valued Member. Although there is not much we can say that will comfort you at a time like this, we do wish to offer our services.

Major Lewis carried \$12,000 Group Life Insurance with this Association. The terms provide that \$2,000 be paid at once as an Emergency Death Benefit, and that \$10,000 be paid in a single sum. A draft in the amount of \$2,000 in payment of the Emergency Death Benefit is enclosed which should be presented at your bank for payment. Please inform us when this has been done.

In order that we may arrange for the payment of the remaining \$10,000, kindly complete the enclosed Proof of Death form where indicated and sign the form in the presence of an impartial person as a witness. Please return it to this Association in the envelope provided.

Eligible survivors of a member of the Uniformed Services who dies while on active duty are entitled to receive benefits from several agencies of the Federal Government. We suggest that you communicate with the Personnel Officer of the nearest Installation of the United States Air Force for information and assistance.
